

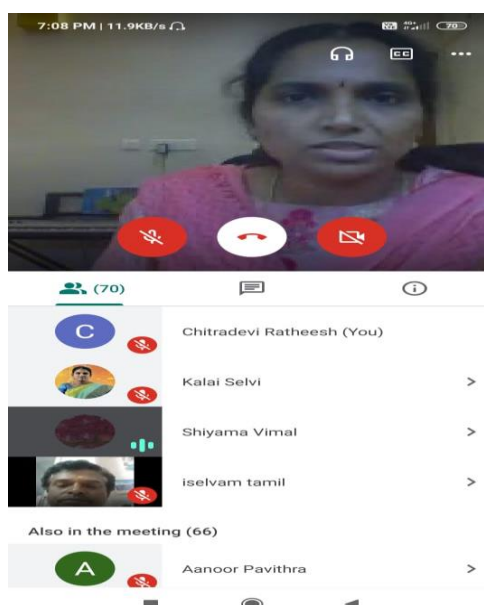

The objective of the programme is to create the BREAST CANCER AWARENESS among the Students and the Public. The summary of the programme. The Seminar was organized to create awareness on Breast cancer among students. This will be a Platform for Students to identify the symptoms of Breast cancer. This Seminar will help students to interact with specialist and clarify their doubts regarding Breast Cancer.

The total beneficiaries were 500.Around 50 participants both students and public participated among 100 persons underwent MAMOGRAM inside the Campus. Two persons were found to have symptoms of Breast Cancer. Doctors advised them for further treatment.



A webinar was organized on 16/03/2020. The topic of the webinar was “An Awareness Programme on COVID 19”. Dr.J.Shiyamini, Psychiatrist was the Resource Person. 170 students participated in the webinar.
