
2.7.1 Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) on overall institutional performance For the Year 2019-2020


Students Satisfaction Survey was conducted among the students through online(google form). The questionnaire was framed on the basis of NAAC guidelines. This Survey focuses on the overall learning experiences of the students. A total of 393 responses were collected from UG and PG students. 69% of the students were satisfied with the syllabus covered,65% of the students satisfied with the classes handled by the faculties and 67% agreed that the teachers had effective communication skill.42% of the students agreed with the good approach of teaching. 48% of the students were satisfied with the Internal evaluation system; 50% of the students agreed with the discussion made on the corrected assignments; 57% of the students approved with the institutions support in improving the cognitive, social and emotional growth. 44.5% of the students agreed with the competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes. 45% of the students were satisfied with the explanations of the concepts. 51% of the students agreed that the faculties were able to identify their weakness and help them to overcome it. 49% of the students agreed that the institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process. 50% of the students agreed with the motivational measures given to participate in curricular and extracurricular activities. 45% of the students were satisfied with the use of ICT tools. 45% of the students agreed with the overall quality of teaching and learning process.


1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 393 responses




2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 393 responses




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate? 393 responses




4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as ³⁹³ responses



5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers. 393 responses




6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 393 responses




7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.




8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.




10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes




















19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.
