2.7.1 Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) on overall institutional performance (Institution may design the questionnaire) (results and details be provided as weblink)



This Survey helps to upgrade the status of the college. We have prepared the questionnaire recommended by NAAC. A total of 553 responses were collected from UG and PG students through google form. Majority (79%) of the students were satisfied with the syllabus covered. Majority (60%) of the student population agreed that the teacher taking class with thoroughly preparation and the majority of students (72%) agreed that the teachers have effective communication skill. Majority (59%) of the students were satisfied with the Internal evaluation system. Majority (58%) of the students accepted the performance of assignment discussion in every time. Majority (58%) of the students were satisfied with the promoting internship, student's exchange

and field visit. Majority (50%) of the students were agreed the institution provides multiple opportunities to growth and learning of students. Majority (53%) of the students accepted that teachers satisfied with the competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes. Majority (57%) of the students were satisfied with the explanations of the concepts through examples and applications. 65% of the students mentioned that the mentors identified their strengths to guide them towards reach their goal. Majority (60%) of the students agreed that teachers were able to identify their weakness and help them to overcome it. 44% of the students agreed the institution makes effort to engage the students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process. Majority (59%) of the students were satisfied with the teachers motivation to participate in extracurricular activities. Majority (58%) of the students agreed with the efforts made by the institute/teachers to inculcate skill development and employability skills. Majority (39%) of the students were satisfied with the use of ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc., while teaching. 





1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 553 responses




2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 553 responses



3. How well were the teachers able to communicate? 553 responses




4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as $_{\rm 553\,responses}$






6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 553 responses




7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.


8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.


9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.


10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes




11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.










17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.


18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.




19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.
